The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has prepared a final environmental impact statement (EIS) related to its review of Westinghouse Electric Company, LLC's (WEC) application to renew its special nuclear material (SNM) license SNM-1107 to continue to operate its Columbia Fuel Fabrication Facility (CFFF) in Hopkins, South Carolina. The final EIS provides the NRC staff's evaluation of the potential environmental impacts of the proposed license renewal.

We are providing three hard copies to the Richland Library per the conversation with NRC staff on June 7, 2022. As discussed, one copy is for the Main Branch and the other two copies are for each of the Eastover and Lower Richland Branches. These are to be maintained as reference documents at the library.
