Gaby Poirier is President of Operating Plants at Westinghouse Electric Company. In this role, he is accountable for the delivery of Westinghouse's core products and services to the global fleet of operating nuclear plants, spanning nuclear fuel, engineered solutions, instrumentation & controls systems, parts and outage & maintenance services. He also leads the strategic deployment of Westinghouse's capital investment projects in support of the company's growth portfolio.

Originally from Quebec, Mr. Poirier brings extensive international experience from senior leadership roles across Canada, the United States, Europe and Australia where he has developed deep operational and manufacturing expertise in diverse commodities such as aluminum, iron ore and copper.

Prior to joining Westinghouse, Mr. Poirier spent four years at Alcoa – serving as Regional Vice President of North America Operations, as well Vice President, Global Transformation and President, Alcoa Canada.

Previously, he worked at Rio Tinto for more than 20 years. Mr. Poirier's senior leadership positions included Managing Director of the Kennecott copper mining and smelting complex in Salt Lake City, Utah; General Manager of the Greater Hope Downs joint venture in Perth, Australia, part of Rio Tinto's Iron Ore product group; General Manager of the Dunkerque aluminum smelter in France; and General Manager of the Kitimat smelter in British Columbia.

He holds bachelor's and master's degrees in chemical engineering from the Université de Sherbrooke and an MBA in Finance from the Université du Québec à Montréal. Mr. Poirier is a certified Lean Six Sigma Black Belt and has also completed the executive education General Management Program at Harvard Business School.
